- We are an independent grant making charity and member of national body of UKCFs
- IVAR flexible funder accredited
- We raise funds and get grants out to local charities, community groups and people
- Based in County Durham for County Durham, Tees Valley and the wider North East

Who can apply?

- Registered charities
- Community/voluntary groups that have a constitution
- Social enterprises (CICs, companies limited by guarantee) that are registered with the appropriate body
 - We support social enterprises that have been running for 12 months, and who can demonstrate that at least 50% of their income is from trade/services

If your income is above £5,000, we need to see registration as a CASC, charity, or incorporation.

This is due to concerns over liability – the management committee of an unincorporated sports club are personally liable for the funds of the club, including grant funds.

Safeguarding policy

- Safeguarding policy with a named officer/lead
- In date and in the name of your organisation (if you're part of a national, you need to have a policy in your local branch name)



What can you apply for?

- Room hire/premises costs
- Items for distribution
- Staff time allocated to a project
- Capital items and equipment (except vehicles or minibuses) - with quotes
- Transport costs



What do we not cover?

- Activities that have already taken place
- Unspecified contributions to large appeals
- Projects that solely support animal welfare
- Fundraising activities
- Contingency funding



Monitoring
