Congratulations on being awarded a grant from the **Community Grants Programme, supported by players of People's Postcode Lottery**, and delivered in partnership with Sported. We think that's something worth shouting about!

To make some noise, this pack contains logos and helpful advice and guidance on how to celebrate your grant.

Talking about this funding demonstrates to other potential donors and funders that you're a trusted organisation and further promotes your work to your followers and local community.

You can do this across your marketing and social media, as outlined below. And why not use photos and videos to bring it to life?

Descriptions and Referencing

The award is from the Community Grants Programme, supported by players of People's Postcode Lottery. When referencing Sported in connection with the funding, please use, 'in partnership with'. For example:

"We are delighted to have been awarded a grant from the Community Grants Programme, supported by players of People's Postcode Lottery and delivered in partnership with Sported."

Dual branded logo

Awards are made through one of the local Postcode Trusts which are integrated with the People's Postcode Lottery.

Please acknowledge the support of players by using the relevant dual brand logo that corresponds to the Trust making your award. Never use the People's Postcode Lottery logo on its own.

For example, if your organisation is awarded funds from People's Postcode Trust you should use that Trust's dual logo. Horizontal and vertical options for each Trust are available via the link below.

If you would like to include a short description of the Community Grants Programme to accompany the logo or any of your promotional activities, such as your website or social media, please use the following:

The programme delivers grants and support to community organisations (like ours) delivering sport and physical activity for wider social purpose."

If you would like to include a short description about People's Postcode Lottery, please use the following:

"Players of [People's Postcode Lottery](#) raise amazing amounts of money for charities. And so far, they've raised more than £1.5 billion for good causes."

"Funding raised by players of People's Postcode Lottery was awarded to Sported to allow them to distribute funds directly to community groups. The incredible support from players of People's Postcode Lottery is helping create opportunities for our next generation while building a strong and resilient society."

If you would like to include a short description about Sported, please use the following:

"Sported is the UK's largest grassroots sport charity, supporting over 5,000 groups and clubs across the UK to transform lives and strengthen communities. Through its free support and funding, it uses the power of sport to help over one million people each year and to make sure no-one is left on the sidelines."
